I form light and create darkness, I make well-being and create calamity, I am the LORD, who does all these things.

Jan. 15: *When I wonder what God is like...*

Who is like you, O LORD, among the gods? Who is like you, majestic in holiness, awesome in glorious deeds, doing wonders?

Feb. 19: *When I wonder what God wants...*

For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to give strong support to those whose heart is blameless toward him.

II Chronicles 16:9a

March 5: *When I wonder what pursuing God means...*

But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ.

Philippians 3:7

March 19: *When I wonder if following Jesus is worth it...*

Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I might gain Christ.

Philippians 3:8

April 2: *When I wonder how great God is...*

Yours, O LORD, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty, for all that is in the heavens and in the earth is yours. Yours is the kingdom, O LORD, and you are exalted as head above all.

I Chronicles 29:11

April 16: *When I wonder what God can do...*

Both riches and honor come from you, and you rule over all. In your hand are power and might, and in your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all.

I Chronicles 29:12

May 7: *People must believe they are sinners...*

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Romans 3:23

May 21: *People must see they cannot save themselves...*

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 6:23

June 4: *People must see Jesus crucified for them...*

But God shows His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 5:8

June 18: *People must trust Christ to save them from sin...*

For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Ephesians 2:8-9

July 2: *Jesus Christ died to pay for sinners' sin...*

He Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed.

1 Peter 2:24

July 16: *Jesus Christ has reconciled sinners to Himself...*

For in Him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through Him to reconcile to Himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of His cross.

Colossians 1:19-20

August 6: *Jesus' blood can perfectly cleanse sinners...*

How much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.

Hebrews 9:14

August 20: *Jesus saves sinners when they trust Him alone...*

Yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.

Galatians 2:16

Sept. 3: *I must rightly fear the Lord...*

Moses said to the people, "Do not fear, for God has come to test you, that the fear of him maybe before you, that you may not sin."

Exodus 20:20

Sept. 17: *I must love the Lord to rest in Him...*

And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.

Romans 8:28

Oct. 1: *I must draw near to the Lord...*

But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

James 4:6

Oct. 15: *I must be humble before the Lord...*

Dec. 3: *I must wait on the Lord...*

Our soul waits for the LORD; he is our help and our shield. For our heart is glad in him, because we trust in his holy name.

Dec. 17: *I must trust in the Lord...*

Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.
